

## **Student Fees, Fines and Charges / Return of Property**

A student may be charged a fee for courses or activities. Every reasonable attempt will be made to keep fees as minimal as possible. The Building Administrator may waive the fee in cases of financial hardship.

Board approval is required to establish fees, increase fees or eliminate fees. Fees may be required for the actual cost of breakage and reasonable supplies used in courses such as commercial, industrial arts, music, domestic science, science or agriculture.

A student shall be responsible for the cost of replacing materials or property that is lost or damaged due to negligence. The District may require, as a condition of participation in commencement activities or before the issuance of a transcript, that all indebtedness incurred by a student be satisfied, or that all books or other instructional material, uniforms, athletic equipment, advances on loans or other personal property of the District be returned. In extreme cases, the Board may pursue repayment via the legal system.
